With the introduction of another category and a larger age range this year's art competition is set to be even bigger. Children have the choice of our traditional food, farming and countryside category, producing a piece of art on any aspect of British food, farming and the countryside or an open category.

We ask pupils to submit their entries in any medium. Due to display space we ask that entries are no larger than A3 where possible. There is no limit to the number of entries per school.

The winning entries will be on display in the School Exhibition Marquee at the Royal Norfolk Show on 28 and 29 June 2017 and prize giving will take place in the marquee on Thursday 30 June. Separate certificates will be sent for Highly Commended Work.

The competition age groups are:

- KS1 (Reception, Year 1 & 2)
- KS2 Lower (Year 3 & 4)
- KS2 Upper (Year 5 & 6)
- KS3 (Year 7, 8 & 9)
- KS4 (Year 10 & 11)
- KS5 (Year 11 & 12)

School prizes are as follows:

1st Prize: £100, Runner Up: £75 for each age group

Pupil prizes are being generously provided by Wex Photographic.

The Competition is open to all schools across East Anglia.

Judging will take place during May. Once Judging has taken place schools will notified **whether entrants have been placed.**
