Working in groups of 3-4 pupils must research and create a news report on an issue related to food, farming and the countryside.

Entries must be submitted in the form of a written newspaper article. A team of judges will select the 15 best schools to have their work displayed at the Royal Norfolk Show on 28 and 29 June 2017 and prize giving will take place in the marquee on Wednesday 28 June. Separate certificates will be sent for Highly Commended Work.

The competition age groups are:
KS2- Year 5 & 6
KS3- Year 7,8 & 9

The competition will tie in with a whole range of subjects including:
English Citizenship, ICT, History, Maths- Stats, figures etc. Geography, Music, Drama and Art, PSHE, Science

The competition is open to all schools across East Anglia.

Judging will take place in May. Once judging has taken place schools will be notified whether entrants have been placed.
