# SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. General.** The Show of Poultry, Rabbits and Cavies will be held in accordance with the rules of the Poultry Club, incorporating the British Bantam Association and the British Rabbit Council. All Classes will be held under the Show Regulations of the Royal Norfolk Agricultural Association, as far as they apply and the following Special Conditions.  
**The Judge's Decision is final.**
- 2. No selling of Rabbits, Cavies, Poultry or Eggs of any type may take place at the Show.** Please note that any eggs laid during the duration of the Show will be destroyed by the Senior Steward.
- 3. Entry forms – please make sure that you complete the correct entry form for the section/s that you wish to enter.** Exhibits will be permitted to compete only in those classes and for those special prizes for which they are entered and for which they are eligible. All Classes are for Open Competition except where otherwise stated. All exhibits entered in Classes marked with an asterisk (\*) must also be entered in a standard class. **A £2.50 First Aid Levy and £1 Postage Fee** will be charged per exhibitor regardless of number of entries submitted. The first Aid Levy and Postage Fee are listed on the entry form and should be included with your payment. If this is not paid, entries will be invalid.
- 4. Cancellation of Classes.** The Prize Schedule is subject to the Orders and Regulations of DEFRA, and classes may be cancelled, if necessary, under such Orders and Regulations. Rabbit Classes will not be cancelled otherwise. Poultry Classes may be amalgamated or cancelled if insufficient entries are received. Separate breed classes for male and female may be amalgamated, or the entries of weak classes may be amalgamated into a Transfer or Any Other Variety Class. In the event of any class being cancelled and the exhibit not being transferred in accordance with the above provisions the entry fees will be returned.
- 5. Delivery – Tuesday.** Exhibits can be delivered to the Small Livestock Tent during show week between **4pm and 7pm on Tuesday.** **Exhibitors should use the entrance via Gate 7 and must have a Small Livestock pick up and drop off car pass.** Labels will be sent for all exhibits. Exhibits must be forwarded in an accepted type of crate, basket or box.  
**Delivery – Wednesday.** Exhibitors attending the Show and displaying a **Small Livestock pick up and drop off car pass may deliver through Gate 7 ONLY.** This gate will be manned **between 6:30am and 7.45am on Wednesday only.** After delivery the vehicle should be parked in any Public Car Park. (ie. Green Car Park, Blue Car Park, Red Car Park, Orange Car Park, Yellow Car Park). **Stock found to be unhealthy on arrival will not be penned and will be dealt with at the discretion of the Association's Veterinary Inspector. The exhibitor will be responsible for any charge/s arising there from.**

6. **Collection – Thursday.** All exhibits must remain in their pens until **4.30pm on Thursday. Entry to the showground can be gained through Gate 27** only between **4.30pm – 7pm, between which times exhibits may be removed.** Exhibits remaining after 7pm do so at the owner's risk.
7. **Responsibility.** From time of arrival to time of despatch or removal, all exhibits will be in the custody of the RNAA, whose stewards are the only authorised persons to handle, pen and unpen the exhibits but they cannot accept any liability. It is a condition of entry that the exhibitor indemnifies the RNAA against all claims for injury, loss or damage to exhibits, equipment and crates. Should an exhibit die, the carcass will be dealt with at the discretion of the RNAA's Veterinary Inspector.
8. **Prize Money.** This will be paid to winners from **4:30pm on Thursday.** Any Prize Money not claimed at that time will be available by collection from the RNAA office within 1 month of the show. Any prize money unclaimed after 1 August 2019 will be returned to the RNAA's funds.
9. **Special Prizes.** All Special Prizes offered by Clubs, unless otherwise stated, are confined to fully paid-up members.
10. **Juvenile Classes.** All juvenile classes are restricted to entries from children **under 16 years of age on the first day of the Show.**
11. **Conduct.** Exhibitors are reminded that push-bikes are to be left in public car parks and/or caravan parks, and not to be ridden around the marquees **NO EXCEPTIONS.**  
The RNAA reserves the right to **refuse entry** to the Royal Norfolk Show Small Livestock Competition to any exhibitor. An exhibitor or any other representative of an exhibitor or member of the general public who conducts themselves in an improper or offensive manner to any Judge, Steward or Official appointed by the RNAA, will be reported to the Chief Executive/Show Director. They may be **refused entry** to the Showground and may **not be allowed to compete** in any class/es or competition/s that they may have entered and any money due to this exhibitor may be **withheld. Entry into any further Shows may also be refused.**
12. **Protests.** An exhibitor or member wishing to lodge a protest regarding an exhibit at this Show must do so in writing and submit to the RNAA's office on the Showground together with the sum of £50 before 6pm on the day that the award was made. Reasons for delay must be otherwise satisfactory. If, on investigation, the protest is not upheld, the sum deposited may be forfeited to the funds of the RNAA.

13. **Admission Tickets.** An exhibitor who is not a member of the RNAA, but who has paid £8 or more in entry fees plus the £2.50 First Aid Levy and £1 Postage Fee will receive a ticket that will admit them to the Show **on both days** free of charge. Please note that tickets will be limited to one per exhibitor per day – subject to entries. Any further tickets should be purchased in advance or on the gate on Show days.
14. **Bio-Security Check.** Upon arrival at the Show a signed Bio-Security Form must be presented and birds will remain isolated and not allowed into the marquee until they have been inspected by the designated Poultry expert and the Bio-Security Form received. If a second opinion is needed the onsite veterinarian will be called.
15. **Parasites. All animals must be free from parasites. Please check your animals before you arrive at the Show. Animals may be refused entry.**
16. **Entry Forms should be returned no later than Friday 24 May 2019.** All entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees. Please send to:

- ii) All classes are for birds of any age.**
- iii) The right is reserved to amalgamate any class with less than 4 entries.**
- iv) Entries in Juvenile classes can be entered in these classes ONLY. They must not be entered in any additional classes.**
- v) This Show is held under PCGB Rules and Exhibitors making entries agree to abide by such rules.**
- vi) All animals must be free from parasites. Please check your animals before you arrive at the Show. Animals may be refused entry.**
- vii) Exhibitors will comply with all bio-security measures including but not limited to:**
  - a. Birds do not originate from premises or areas which are under restrictions related to confirmation of a notifiable avian disease, including from any temporary disease controlled zone or Avian Influenza Protection and Surveillance Zones imposed by Ministers.
  - b. The birds entered have not attended a poultry gathering in the previous 13 days, nor have any other birds been brought onto the premises of origin in the past 13 days.
  - c. The animals intended to exhibit at the Royal Norfolk Show have been health-checked before travelling to the Show and to the best of your knowledge have not been in contact with any notifiable avian disease agents and do not show any signs of infection.

d. Upon arrival at the Show a signed Bio-Security Form must be presented and birds will remain isolated and not allowed into the marquee until they have been inspected by the designated Poultry expert and the Bio-Security Form received. If a second opinion is needed the onsite veterinarian will be called.

e. The cage, crate, basket, receptacle or other container will not be contaminated with bird droppings or other material of bird origin, other than faeces produced during the transportation of the birds to the Show. Should the designated poultry expert find your cage, crate, basket, receptacle or other container to be visibly contaminated you will not be allowed to exhibit and be asked to leave the Showground immediately.

f. The birds travelling from the Show whether they are returning stock or going to a new location will be isolated from other birds at the premises and health monitored for at least one week after the Show.
