- v) Exhibits must be on the **Showground by 1pm on Monday 24 June**. Exhibitors are not required to remain.
- vi) A brief written description of the entry must accompany the entry form. A summary of the description will be displayed on the exhibit.
- vii) **A presentation of results will take place on Wednesday at 3pm at the NORMAC stand.**
- viii) Exhibits may only be removed from the Showground between **7pm on Thursday 27 June and Sunday 30 June**.
- ix) **Exhibits are placed on the Showground at the owner's risk.**
